- Our investment transforms artists careers – in 2011 all of the shortlisted artists for the Turner Prize had had shows at Site Gallery within the last 5 years.

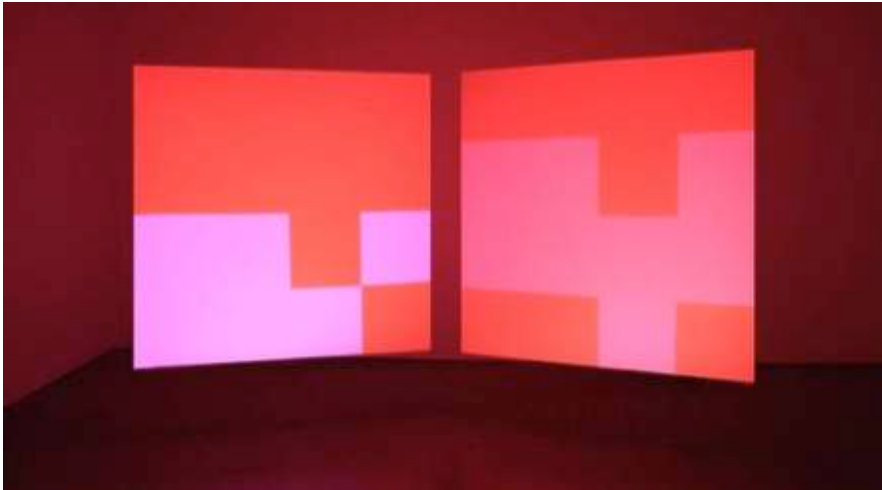
