TCO, in close cooperation with Chevron Shipping, made the decision to establish the Kazakhstan Maritime Academy in Almaty (KMA) as one of the faculties of the Kazakh British Technical University (KBTU)

The KMA started August 2012. Presently there are 24 1st year students and 20 2nd year students and 17 3rd year students (at seagoing apprenticeship). The 2nd year students are attending 5 short STCW courses in Netherlands and will start their one year apprenticeship coming summer. 3rd year students are embarked on board of various vessels with different shipping companies such as Chevron, Anthony Veder, Bernhard Schulte Management, KazMorTransFlot and Caspian Offshore Construction



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







S/V Eendracht

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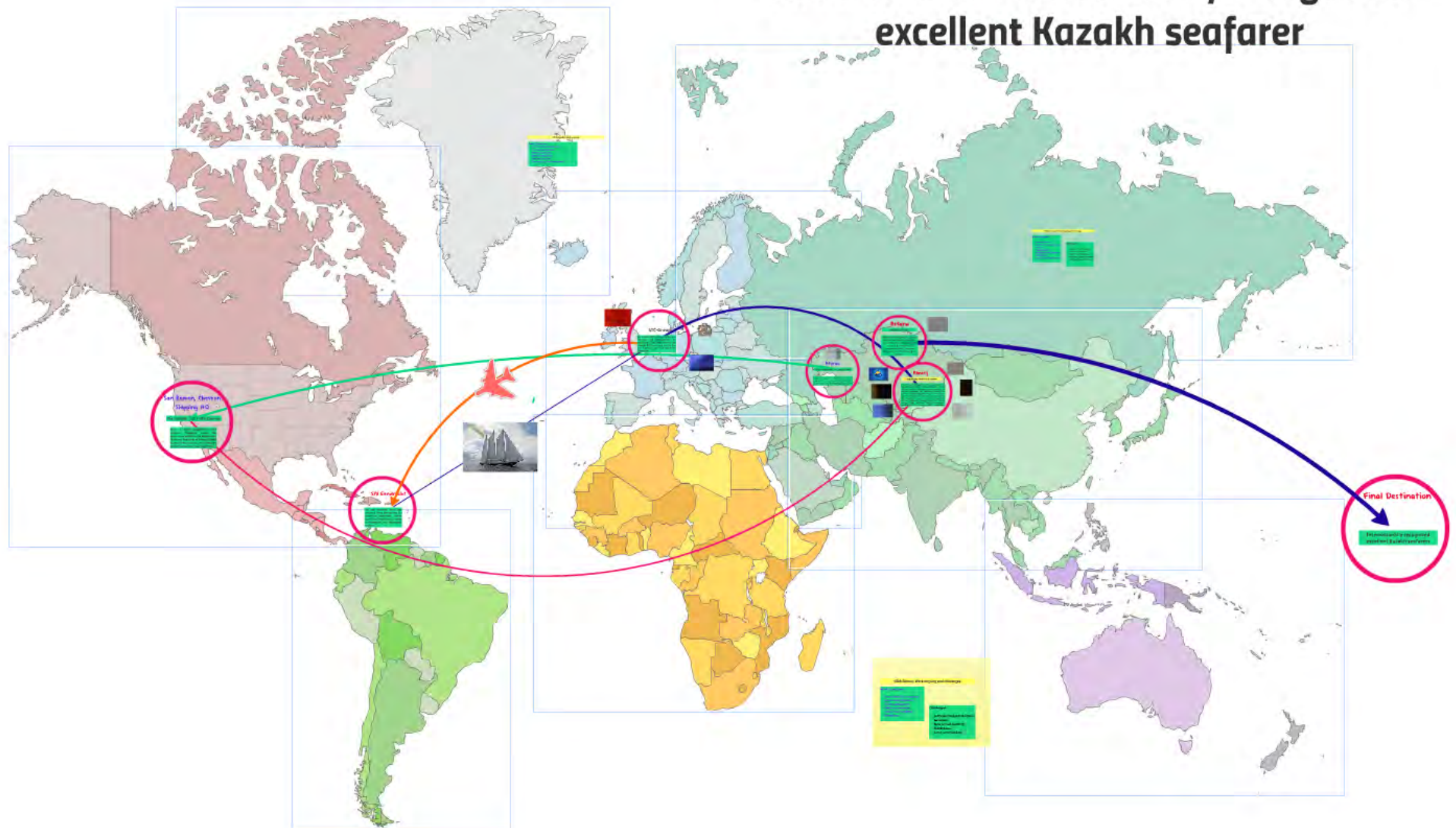
